Who can I ask if I have questions about my health?

<u>III</u> CHUM

Are you a patient at the CHUM? Do you have concerns about your health that are related to the reason you're being followed at the CHUM? You can call the CHUM Patient Health Line to be assessed by a nurse.

What number do I call?

CHUM Patient Health Line:

This service is **only for CHUM patients.** Your call also must **be related to the reason you're being followed at the CHUM.** The CHUM Patient Health Line offers a telephone assessment by a nurse for a non-urgent health problem, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

After assessing your situation, the nurse will direct you to the right place and the right expert for your needs. This service is in addition to the service provided by your health care team.

For example, you could call the CHUM Patient Health Line because:

- you have questions or concerns about an operation, an examination, or a procedure;
- you have side effects from new medications or after a treatment;
- you have to look after your own care;
- your health status has changed.

When you call, make sure you have your health insurance (RAMQ) card on hand.



ATTENTION! -

If you or a loved one has a serious problem that requires immediate medical care, call 911.

The CHUM Patient Health Line is not an emergency service.
