

Research Professor position: research on burn care at the CHUM Research Center – Faculty of Medicine, Université de Montréal

The Research Centre of CHUM (CRCHUM) in partnership with the Faculty of Medicine of the Université de Montréal (UdeM) and the *Centre d'expertise des victimes de brûlures graves de l'ouest du Québec* is seeking applicants for an assistant or associate research professor in the burn care research field. The candidate must have competencies and experience related to basic research on burn care.

It is expected that the candidate work in close collaboration with the *Centre d'expertise des victimes de brûlures graves de l'ouest du Québec* to foster knowledge translation and strengthen research capacities in the field.

Functions

Development and realization of an active fundamental research program in burn care research and/or regenerative medicine and/or tissue engineering; supervision of student research including medical residents, contribution to the scientific community; contribution to the academic life of the Faculty and reinforcement of research capacities and knowledge transfer in training clinical settings.

Requirements

Applicants must hold a Ph.D. degree in an appropriate discipline with postdoctoral experience and a strong publication record. The candidate will be expected to develop an innovative and externally funded research program and collaborations with other researchers of the CRCHUM Immunopathology research theme. In addition, the candidate will contribute to teaching as well as to some administrative and academic activities at CRCHUM and UdeM.

A good knowledge of the healthcare system in Canada/Quebec and communication skills in French and English (oral and written) are assets.

Application submission

Interested applicants must submit a letter of interest describing their proposed research program in the field of interest and explaining how their previous training supports this program, a curriculum vitae and the names of three references (applicant agreement will be sought before contacting the reference names provided) **by January 31st, 2021**.
